# CRC 1453 | NephGen Junior Fellowship

The CRC 1453 would like to promote highly talented, motivated and successful scientists in the field of Genetic Kidney Disease, who are in the transition phase from postdoc to group leader.

The NephGen Junior Fellowship will include 30.000 Euro from the CRC 1453 Nephrogenetics, and successful awardees will become associate members of the CRC. We will support a project in the area of Genetic Kidney Disease, ranging from basic molecular research to translational, patient-based studies.

We specifically encourage applications aiming at:

- kidney disease genes and their signaling pathways
- kidney cancer and development
- cross-talk between kidney and other cell types
- ion and transporters and channels in the kidney

Applications must include a CV, project proposal (max. two pages), list of publications, a simple spending plan (flexible funding period but no longer than 31.12.2022) and a support letter of the respective PI. Suitable candidates will be shortlisted and will be invited to present their project to the CRC 1453 steering committee.

Female scientists are especially encouraged to apply.
